Restoril for Insomnia: How Temazepam Works and What to Consider

When May Restoril Be Prescribed?

Restoril may be prescribed when insomnia involves difficulty falling asleep or staying asleep and when a healthcare professional determines that short-term medication is appropriate.

Before recommending temazepam, a healthcare provider may consider factors such as the duration of insomnia, possible underlying causes, other medical conditions, current medications, age, and the potential for dependence or misuse.
